## Supplies:

- **Stamp Set/Dies:** Capturing Smiles Bundle ([167133](#))
- **Stamp Pads:** Basic Black Hybrid Stampin' Pad ([166648](#))
- **Paper:** Misty Moonlight Cardstock ([153081](#)); Real Red Cardstock ([102482](#)); Basic Black Cardstock ([121045](#)); Basic White Cardstock ([166780](#))
- **Stampin' Blends Combo Packs:** Basic Black ([154843](#)); Smoky Slate ([154904](#)); Daffodil Delight ([154883](#)); Lemon Lolly ([161673](#)); Night of Navy ([154891](#)); Pumpkin Pie ([154897](#)); Gray Granite ([154886](#)); Granny Apple Green ([154885](#))
- **Accessories/Tools:** Mini Stampin' Dimensionals ([144108](#)); Wink of Stella Glitter Brush ([141897](#)); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine ([149653](#)); Stampin' Seal ([152813](#)); Adhesive Sheets ([152334](#)) OR Multipurpose Liquid Glue ([110755](#)); White Gel Pens ([166642](#))

## Measurements:

- Misty Moonlight Cardstock: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock: 2" x 5-1/4", 3" x 5"
- Basic Black Cardstock: 2-1/4" x 5-1/2", 3" x 6"
- Real Red Cardstock: scrap
- Adhesive Sheet: 3" x 6"

## Instructions:

1. Score and fold the Misty Moonlight cardstock at 4 1/4" to form the card base.
2. Add the Adhesive Sheet to the Basic Black Cardstock, then die cut two film strips, set aside.
3. Die cut a heart from the scrap of Real Red Cardstock, then coat with Wink of Stella. Set aside.
4. Stamp the square images twice on the 3" x 5" Basic White Cardstock with Basic Black Hybrid Ink
5. Color images as desired with Stampin' Blends. Add dots with the White Gel Pen to create a starry sky on the city images.
6. Die cut images with square die.

7. Partially peel Adhesive Sheet liner on die cut film strips - leave in place behind the tabs. With both tabs pointing left, adhere images in place behind square openings. Add some Stampin' Seal behind the images and remove the rest of the liner.
8. Adhere both strips to the Basic White Cardstock piece. Attach the piece on the right side first, aligning the edge of the die cut with the edge of the Basic White piece, and the tab towards the center of the card. Attach the second piece so that the end covers the first piece's tab (the second piece's tab will hang off the edge of the cardstock). Trim the tab off the second piece so it looks like one continuous strip.
9. Stamp "Everyday" and "moments" in Hybrid Black ink above the strip. Attach this piece onto the Basic Black cardstock, and then to the cardfront.
10. Adhere the heart beside the sentiment with a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
